





## 19<sup>th</sup>/20<sup>th</sup> January 2019 Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Friends,

The theme of this weekend's liturgy is 'Peace', very appropriately I think in a world order that is so noisy, aggressive and angry about many things. I do not pretend to know the answer, but the following words of Thomas Merton, a Trappist Monk will, I hope, give us all food for thought.

**“There is a pervasive form of contemporary violence to which the idealist most easily succumbs: Activism and overwork. The rush and pressure of modern life are a form, perhaps the most common form, of its innate violence. To allow oneself to be carried away by a multitude of conflicting concerns, to surrender to too many demands, to commit oneself to too many projects, to want to help everyone in everything, is to succumb to violence. The frenzy of our activism neutralises our work for peace and destroys the fruitfulness of our own work because it kills the root of inner wisdom which makes work fruitful.”**

I am just grateful that I have lived to see this day; to celebrate with Parishioners and Family the journey this far. Deo Gratias.
