

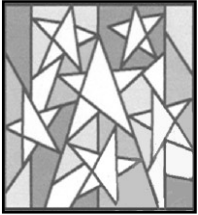

9th/10th March 2019 First Sunday of Lent

Dear Friends,

As we set out on the journey of Lent we are reminded in today's reading about the importance of God's Word in Scripture. Let us not forget that Jesus was fully a human being open to human needs (e.g. food, liquid and emotional love) and also to our challenges or temptations on many fronts, as the devil was well aware. So to these temptations his defence was to rely on the word of sacred scripture (God's Word). On this occasion it repelled the power of Satan, he would return several times again. For us, a working knowledge of scripture is essential, it's not the spare wheel in our car (which may never be needed), it's the steering wheel and we are responsible for what the car does and where it goes. Make the reading of the New Testament at least your friend – a bit at a time.
